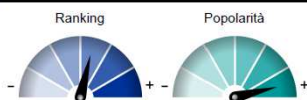

FROM CANCER TO HEART, NEW FRONTIERS

In Italy, some 70% of people diagnosed with cancer today go on to beat the disease, a 15% rise over the last 10 years, the Italian Association of Medical Oncology (AIOM) said. Survival rates were higher for the most common tumour, breast cancer, at 91%. There have been "significant" advances in treatment but not many steps forward in prevention by changing lifestyles, it said, saying that 41% of cancers are avoidable.

Doctors can to observe the patient's heart as if they had in their hand? "Exactly. Among the modern medical equipment we have introduced Synapse 3D, which displays on the monitor three-dimensional images of the patient's heart: it is reproduced by the software-image of the complete heart in all its parts, with a quality and precision such as to allow cardiologists to catch even the smallest anomalies in cardiac both vascular. Images never before seen that enable immediate diagnosis of the disease, for an effective assessment and immediate initiation of treatment". Mr. Iseni, why create a heart center? "Because cardiovascular disease in Italy have a huge impact on public health and on the health and economic resources. According to Istat (the National Statistical Office), the spending in Italy for cardiac surgery is estimated at over 700 million euro per year. Prevention, diagnosis and early treatment dramatically reduces levels of mortality, suffering and social costs".
